Articles of Amendment, Historic Bath Foundation

The text of each amendment adopted is as follows:

1. ARTICLE III

- a. Change Paragraph A to read:
 - A. To encourage, advocate, preserve, protect, promote, and financially support the historic aspects and architectural heritage of the Town of Bath and surrounding area, and
- b. Add Paragraph B as follows:
 - B. To aid the Historic Bath Commission and the North Carolina Department of Cultural Resources in acquiring and developing historic properties, interpretations, and functions, and
- c. Add Paragraph C as follows:
 - C. To conduct fund raising activities to raise funds to acquire and restore historic properties/objects, provide interpretations and functions and to enable the Historic Bath Commission, ,the Historic Bath State Historic Site, and citizens of Bath and the surrounding area to fully and completely present the history of North Carolina's first town, and
- d. Add Paragraph D as follows:
 - D. To carry on any other lawful act or activity which a corporation shall be organized under North Carolina General Statues, Chapter 55A: North Carolina Nonprofit Corporation Act.
- 2. ARTICLE V Change ARTICLE V to read as follows:

The Corporation shall have nine (9) Directors, who shall be elected as follows: Nine (9) members shall be elected by the membership' In addition, the Corporation shall have as ex-officio, non-voting members of the Board of Directors, those persons holding the following positions:

- a. Chairman of the Historic Bath Commission.
- b. Mayor of the Town of Bath.
- c. Site Manager of the Historic Bath State Historic Site.
- d. President of Bath High School Preservation.
